Friday, September 3 — PRACTICE

- Range is open for check-in all day and open for practice immediately following the PSL Match (Approx. 2:30)
- Competitor information (bench and relay) will be available after 6 p.m. and will be posted in the clubhouse and on the firing line (next to the announcers booth).
- Name tags will be provided for all competitors and must be worn at all times while at the range. Included with the name tag are two entry forms. One for the BRRC Door Prizes and ONE for the ARA Project Rifle and other Prizes. **DO NOT LOSE YOUR NAME TAG!**

Saturday, September 4 — FIVE targets

- Targets will be available for pick up in the clubhouse beginning at 8 a.m.
- Competition begins **promptly** at 9 a.m.
- The relays will shoot in order: 1-2-3.
- Food will be available in the clubhouse, however, due to the number of competitors, there will not be a break for lunch. There is plenty of time to eat between relays.

Sunday, September 5 — THREE targets

- Competition resumes **promptly** at 9 a.m.
- The relays will shoot in reverse order: 3-2-1.
- As each relay sets up for the final target of the Tournament, ARA representatives will collect the entry forms for the Door Prizes and the Project Rifle giveaway. Forms are preprinted with the competitor name and are located behind your name tag.
- One hour after the final targets are shot, everyone should gather in the large pavilion for door prizes, followed by the awarding of plaques and trophies.
- The ARA Project Rifle will be given away immediately after the trophy presentation. **You must be present to win!**
